

Job Title: General Assistant (GA122)

Reporting to the Sales Manager you will:

- Use the till point to make shop sales and assist customers with purchases.
- Help the sales team maintain the sales vehicles with promotional materials, general cleanliness and washing the vehicles.
- Empty bins and clean customer areas as required.
- Respond to email enquiries, handle telephone calls and take and pass on messages, where necessary.
- Provide support to other departments as and when required.

The above is not an exhaustive list of duties and you will be expected to perform different tasks as necessitated by your line manager and the overall business objectives.

Type of contract: This is a part-time position and full training will be provided to the successful candidate.

Hours of work: 8 hours per week on Saturdays. Normal hours will be 8.30am – 5.30pm including one hour for a lunch break. Additional hours during school holidays may be available, subject to statutory regulations. Holiday pay will be given and time off during school holidays is also a legal requirement for school age children.

Salary: £6.00 per hour (minimum for age 15), negotiable if bringing previous experience. We are a Real Living Wage Employer.

Location: Travel to us by bus. Highland Campervans is based on the A96 near Inverness Airport and the main bus route from Inverness to Nairn passes our entrance, with a sheltered bus stop at Tornagrain. From the end of January 2022, all young people in Scotland will be entitled to free bus travel.
